



Educational Trainers

The role is specifically for **face-to-face or online delivery** of our training in schools and workplaces **through the Irish language**.

For f2F sessions, all trainers will be required to have access to their own transport (car/motorbike: mileage is included in the trainer fee to cover the expense of fuel) and laptop.



Please note that all applications must be accompanied by a cover letter demonstrating your interest in the field of online safety education.

This role is contract for services and part-time, but there is no designated number of hours per week. Hours worked will depend on how many school bookings we have in any given week. We have recently received funding from COGG to create our educational offerings for an Irish-speaking audience of children and parents.

Please **do not apply** if you are not based in Ireland, as the job cannot be always carried out remotely.

ROLE SPECIFICATION

Training & Development:

- To deliver interactive online safety training sessions to parents, teachers and children.
- To liaise with school principals / representatives as required.
- To stay up to date on trends, apps and games that children are using.

Reporting:

- To complete a simple trainer session report following each session and to send summary reports via Salesforce
- To report any child protection issues or disclosures to the CyberSafeKids Designated Child Liaison Officer in line with the CyberSafeKids Child Protection Policy

Applicants for this contract must have:

Essential

- A full command of written and spoken Irish at C1/C2 level.
- A minimum of two years' experience in a field relating to education, internet safety, cybercrime, IT security or digital media.
- Experience presenting, teaching or facilitating training sessions with adults and children.
- A good understanding of the online environment and familiarity with apps and games that children are currently using.



- A full clean driver's license is required, and applicants must be prepared to travel. Successful applicants are expected to provide their own roadworthy transport. Trainers are compensated for mileage.
- Stable internet connection and competence using Zoom.

Desirable

• Knowledge of the Irish primary education system.

Applications should be in the form of a covering letter of application and CV (max 2 pages) in English, and be emailed to hei@cybersafekids.ie with "Trainer Vacancy" in the subject line.

Interviews will be held via Zoom.

Successful candidates will be required to attend one half-day training sessions online, and all training materials will be provided.
